The second call for the **Ernst Mach Follow Up Grant (EZA)** which is financed by the Federal Ministry of Science, Research and Economics (BWF) is opened! Within this programme **former scholarship holders of the OeAD from Non European Developing Countries** (see list [here](#)), who have a doctorate degree and who had received a scholarship financed by the Republic of Austria (either Federal Ministry of Science, Research and Economics or Austrian Development Cooperation) can apply for a short research stay in Austria.

Eligible for application are **PhD holders or post-docs from Non European Developing Countries** who are pursuing research or teaching at a higher education institution / university from all areas of study or research.

Maximum age: **50 years (born on or after October 1st, 1963)**

Duration: 1 to 3 months

Closing date for application is 1 October 2014
