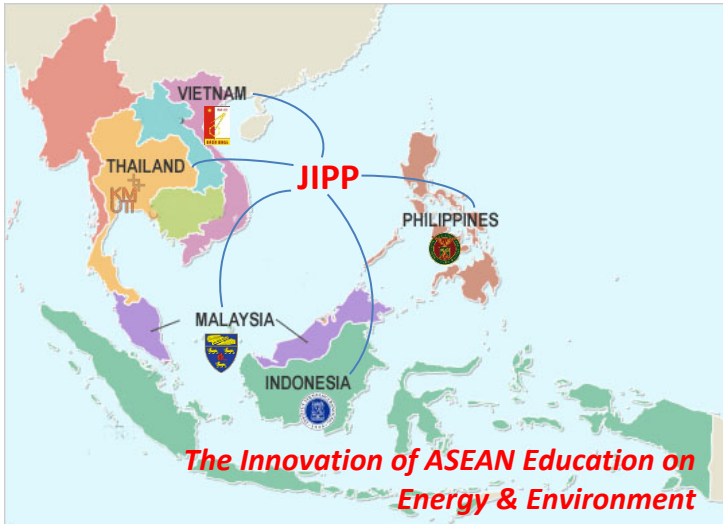


JIPP

Our objectives

- ✚ Produce postgraduate students that can understand and find solution on energy and environmental issues with the view of the ASEAN region
- ✚ Support non-boundary competent human resources across ASEAN region
- ✚ Stimulate joint research and development among ASEAN universities.

King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT) is one of the well-recognized universities on education and research on energy aspects including the international collaboration on energy research. KMUTT has realized the need to understand energy situation of Asean Economics Community (AEC) and initiate the special joint research based program on "Joint International Post-Graduate Program on ASEAN Energy and Environment (JIPP)". In this program, 5 participating institutions from Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Vietnam and Thailand have agreed to collaborate in JIPP.

JIPP provide the chances for ASEAN students to study and research on the interesting energy topics related both in their country and other ASEAN countries. This will be done by the mechanism of co-supervisor from member universities. Students will also experience in learning the current situation of energy and environment in ASEAN by competent professors from 5 joint universities as well as at least 1 semester study abroad in one of the member universities.

JIPP is a non-boundary human resource development and network of experts working to find solution on the energy and environmental issues with the view of the ASEAN region, aiming to fill the gap on the collaboration on research and development among the universities in the member countries and enhance power of negotiation and economic competitiveness of the region. In addition, JIPP is a forum to strengthen research collaboration and sharing of knowledge in energy and environment in ASEAN.

FEATURES OF THE JOINT MASTER PROGRAM

- ✚ JIPP provides both Master and Doctoral Program with two schemes:
Scheme I Joint thesis among partner universities
Scheme II Joint curriculum offered by the participating universities
The joint curriculum will be drafted jointly among the respective university members.
- ✚ Students apply through their respective national university.
- ✚ Approximately 5 to max. 8 students are expected from each country to join the Joint Master and Doctoral Program each year.
- ✚ Students from other ASEAN countries can apply as well through one of the five member universities.
- ✚ The degree will be awarded by each university where students come from.
