Air Access

Noi Bai International Airport: the biggest airport in northern Vietnam, serves the capital city of Hanoi. The airport is located 40 km from the city center. When exiting Noi Bai International Airport, you will see lines to queue for taxis, with a sign stating that it costs about 20 USD to Hanoi Center. In case that you want to save your money for the taxi, then you can catch a airport bus instead (the end stop point at 01 Quang Trung street, Hoan Kiem district, Ha Noi, which are within 500 m distance of the conference venue). The one way ticket is 40,000 vnd (about 2 USD).



Public transport:☐

The public bus system in Hanoi is very cheap but confusing, and few short-term visitors to Hanoi will attempt it. There are around 60 bus routes operated by five different bus operators, but information for all routes can be found on the website of the Hanoi Transport Management and Operation Centre (www.hanoibus.com). Monthly passes are available.
