




[List of EXEMPTION OF ENTRY VISA TO VIETNAM](#)

Only citizens of certain countries can visit Vietnam without an entry visa. They include:

- Most citizens of ASEAN member-countries: Thailand, Indonesia, Singapore, Malaysia, Cambodia, and Lao citizens do not need a Vietnam visa if they are visiting the country within 30 days; passport holders from the Philippines do not need a visa for 21 days; Brunei passport holders are not required to get a visa to Vietnam for 15 days. They could apply for popular passport type with return tickets. Citizens of Myanmar and Timor-Leste are all required Visa to Vietnam. But you must have return ticket if they arrive to Vietnam via visa exemption.

- Passport holders from Korea, Japan, Russia and the Scandinavian nations (Norway, Denmark, Sweden, and Finland) do not need a visa to Vietnam if they intend to stay in the country within 15 days. But they must have return ticket if they arrive to Vietnam via visa exemption.

 Under the government's Resolution No.46/NQ-CP issued on June 18, 2015, Vietnam will grant visa exemptions for citizens from five countries - the **UK, France, Germany, Spain and Italy** - for stays no longer than

15 days

. The Resolution will be in effect for one year, beginning July 1, 2015 and ending on June 30, 2016, and will apply to all types of passports.

Therefore, the two groups above need to apply Vietnam visa if they want to stay the free period longer than prescribed.

There are **two ways** to collect your entry visa:

- Collect at the Vietnamese Embassy/Consulate in your country.

- Collect at an airport in Vietnam: Ho Chi Minh City / Hanoi / Danang ([landing visa](#)).

Both are supplied before arrival in Vietnam.

Other Exceptions:

No visa required for travel in Vietnam for less than 90 days or several visits within 6 months - Citizens of France holding valid diplomatic or official passports.

No Vietnam visa required for travel within 60 days - Citizens of Chile holding valid diplomatic or official passports.

No visa Vietnam required for 60 days/time with APEC Business Travel Card (ABTC) Holders from Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation (APEC) member economies

No visa required for Vietnamese overseas for less than 90 days staying if they are holding Vietnam visa exemption certificate.

After receiving your informations, we will be applying to the Immigration Department in Vietnam to get the visa [approval letter](#) , which we will send to you by email. You can expect the process to take 5 to 7 working days.

Collect your visa

- Collect at the Vietnamese Embassy/Consulate in your country. Fill this visa [application form](#) , attach your personal photo (4cmx6cm), and bring it with the visa approval letter to the Embassy/Consulate in your country to collect your visa. You will need to pay USD 45 for the visa fee.

- Collect at an airport in Vietnam: Ho Chi Minh City / Hanoi / Danang ([landing visa](#)). Fill this visa [application form](#) , attach your personal photo (4cmx6cm), and bring it along with you. Use the visa approval letter for boarding check. Upon arrival at airport, present the application form and visa approval letter with your passport to the Immigration Department (Landing visa collecting desk) and pay a visa fee of USD 45 to collect your visa.
